PAUL And you

PAUL And none of this was in the hiring manual.
T I want you to meet them.
PAUL Who?
T The person I fell in love with.
PAUL I'm not gonna wait around. I'm not gonna
T We're having lunch. You can join us.

# SCENE 3.

(Transition. They have lunch. BERBERT is with them.)
T Paul, I want you to meet Berbert.
PAUL Nice to
BERBERT Berbert.
PAUL T speaks very highly of you.
BERBERT Berbert.
PAUL Does he
T No. All they say is "Berbert."
PAUL And this is the one you're in love with?
T Yeah. Look into Berbert's eyes.
BERBERT Berbert.
PAUL Yes, they are very soulful.
T Right?
PAUL ButMaybe someone else, a little more
T Love does not put on airs!! You said that.

I know, but you're taking it out of context.

I'm full of love now for everyone. Berbert fills my cup over.

Okay, well I guess I'm happy, it's just-- I thought you and me would have a go of it one day.

# **PAUL**

I thought that too. I did. But you were always out of town and you know, HR would frown upon it.

### PAUL

HR would frown upon this!

# **BERBERT**

Berbert.

Thank you for being happy for me.

#### PAUL

Well thank you for pretending. And thanks for coming down to the office. And for smoothing it over with HR.

# **PAUL**

Oh you want me to--
